PERFORMANCE

- → Record Net Profit After Tax of \$24.6m
- → Total Revenue reduced by 8.5% to \$229.7m
- → Passenger numbers declined by 5.0% to 1.24m

Rex Group Revenue and PAT Evolution




PILOT SITUATION

- → Resignation rates remained low
- → Cadet Programme enabled surplus pilot numbers
- → 0.2% cancellation rate, the lowest in Australia and consistent with past levels before the pilot crisis of 07/08

NETWORK CHANGES

- → Resumed Griffith Melbourne in Q2
- → Q2 started Townsville Mackay in competition with QantasLink
- → Exit of Townsville Mackay in Jan 2010 due to QantasLink predatory pricing
- Q3 commenced Northern 1 & 2 QLD Gov subsidised routes
- → Commenced Townsville Mount Isa direct service in Feb 2010

CAPITAL EXPENDITURE

- → Completed \$21m pilot academy (AAPA) based in Wagga Wagga
- Acquired 4 Kingairs for \$29m (bank financed)
- → Acquired a \$1.4m warehouse next to the Rex HQ
- Purchased a \$1.2m house next to Rex HQ
- → Share Buy Back of 494k shares (\$377k)
- + \$10m of investment brought forward to benefit from Government's Investment Allowance scheme









RUBBT

- Rex took delivery of last 8 Saab 340B+ leased aircraft
- → AAPA took delivery of 8 new Piper Warrior and 2 new twin engine Piper Seminole aircraft
- → Pel-Air took delivery of 4 new Beechcraft Kingair B200 C aircraft for AV project
- → No disposal of aircraft in the period









TENDER UPDATE

Tenders Won

- → Fly in/Fly out contract with Illuka Resources
- → Cwlth Air Transport Deed of Standing Offer
- QLD regulated and subsidised N1 & N2 routes
- Air Ambulance Victoria
- → Whole of Australian Gov travel
- → Victorian Gov tender for the provision of Domestic/Regional Air services









TENDER UPDATE

Tenders Pending

- → NT aero medical service
- → Air Defence Target System (JP66)









Pel-Air

- → Reduced jet medivac operations
- → Fly in/fly out business continued to grow in line with resource strength
- → Stationed 1 A model Saab in QLD to capture growth opportunities in the resources industry









Air Link

- → Continued developing charter service and growing 3rd party aircraft maintenance business
- → Commenced FIFO operation out of Townsville with B1900









AAPA

- → Received occupancy cert in Jan 2010
- → Attained RTO and CRICOS accreditation in Q3 ready to accept overseas students
- → 35 cadets from intakes 1 & 2 graduated whilst29 were under training
- → Campus officially opened on 27 May 2010 by Minister Anthony Albanese
