PERFORMANCE FY 16/17

Operational PBT quadrupled to \$17.8M

- → Modest recovery in passenger numbers (3%) and yield (3%) across Rex's traditional network bringing \$7M additional revenue
- Additional 8 months of contribution from WA routes
- → Fuel cost reduction of over \$6M from lower fuel price
- Slight improvement in FX rate for AUD

- → Oct-16 Commenced operations in new Sydney warehouse











REX CADET CPT & FO POPULATION

SUBSEQUENT EVENTS

- Commenced Adelaide Port Augusta regulated route
- 21 Vietnamese cadets started in AAPA
- Pel-Air secured FIFO contracts with Iluka and Cobham
- Acquired one Saab340B Aircraft for increased work
- Fuel hedged till Nov 2017 bringing \$1M savings
- → Rex named Asia Pacific regional airline of the year 2017 (4th award in last 10 years)

TENDERS

The Rex Group participating in the following tenders:

- → WA Gov tender for regulated air services between Perth and Carnarvon / Monkey Mia to commence 2 July 2018
- Victoria Police tender for air surveillance aircraft to commence operations on January 2019



 ADF tender for fast jet support capability to commence operations in 3Q 2019









OUTLOOK

Headwinds

- → AUD could revert to dovish if US raises rate aggressively
- Protectionist measures by USA could provoke a trade war and stifle global economic growth
- North Korea situation could easily spiral out of control









OUTLOOK

Tailwinds

- Pax nos. in first 4 months of FY 18 continue trend of modest recovery (+4% yoy)
- Fuel price expected to be range bound
- Mining FIFO appears to be firming
- Enrolments at AAPA expected to grow









PROFIT FORECAST

- Australian economy expected to continue on its modest recovery and will translate to a similar growth in Rex's passenger numbers.
- → Unaudited accounts of the first trimester indicate a PBT increase of 60% over the prior period.
- → Full year PBT expected to exceed prior FY by over 20%.









DIVIDEND

- Final dividend paid on FY17 at 10c per share fully franked
- The Board notes that there are no major capital expenditure forecast for FY18
- The Board reaffirms its commitment to a healthy dividend payout ratio if the Group achieves its profit target in FY18
