REX SELECTED FOR WHOLE OF AUSTRALIAN GOVERNMENT (WoAG) AIR TRAVEL SERVICES PANEL

Regional Express (Rex) has been selected by the Australian Government as one of 18 domestic and international airlines appointed to the air travel services panel to provide scheduled air services for the Whole of Australian Government (WoAG). The agreement will be for five years, beginning 1 May 2016.

Rex is one of three Australian carriers selected on the panel, along with Qantas Airways (including Jetstar) and Virgin Australia. This continues Rex's involvement in providing air travel services to the Australian Government, as under the previous arrangements Rex had been appointed to the WoAG air travel services panel since 2010.

Regional Express (Rex) is Australia's largest independent regional airline operating a fleet of more than 50 Saab 340 aircraft on some 1,500 weekly flights to 58 destinations throughout all states in Australia. In addition to the regional airline Regional Express, the **Rex Group** comprises wholly owned subsidiaries **Pel-Air Aviation** (air freight and charter operator), **Air Link** (Dubbo-based regional airline) and the **Australian Airline Pilot Academy**.
