### REX SUBSIDIARY PEL-AIR AWARDED AIR AMBULANCE VICTORIA TENDER

Regional Express (Rex) today announced that wholly-owned subsidiary Pel-Air has inked an agreement with the Victorian State Government for the provision of Fixed Wing Patient Transport Services.

This follows the announcement in July 2009 that Pel-Air was selected as the conditional preferred tenderer. The 10-year contract will commence in mid-2011 and entails the supply of fixed-wing air transport to Ambulance Victoria for medical evacuation of patients to and from regional areas. Details of the contract remain confidential.

Jim Davis, Managing Director of Regional Express, commented today that “Pel-Air is extremely proud to have been selected by the Victorian Government to carry out this important contract. It is gratifying to have our expertise in this area recognised in this fashion and we look forward to working with Ambulance Victoria over the next ten years to supply a first class patient transport service.”

Pel-Air is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Regional Express Holdings Ltd. which is a publicly-listed company on the Australian Stock Exchange. Regional Express (Rex) is Australia’s largest independent regional airline operating a fleet of over 40 SAAB 340 aircraft on more than 1,300 flights weekly to 35 regional destinations throughout New South Wales, Victoria, South Australia and Queensland. Besides Pel-Air, the Rex Group also comprises Dubbo-based charter operator Air Link, as well as the Australian Airline Pilot Academy operating from Wagga Wagga.
