REX ANNOUNCES EXIT DATE FROM BALLINA

Regional Express (Rex) today announces that services to Ballina will cease from Sunday March 29, 2020.

The last service, ZL211 will depart Ballina at 6:30am on Saturday March 28.

All passengers with bookings after this date will be offered alternative flights between Lismore and Sydney or a full refund.

As for Rex's announcement to withdraw from Kangaroo Island, Rex will allow for a reasonable period for Qantas to match Rex's 2-3 daily services before withdrawing so there will be no disruption to local residents and tourists.

Regional Express (Rex) is Australia's largest independent regional airline operating a fleet of 60 Saab 340 aircraft on some 1,500 weekly flights to 60 destinations throughout all states in Australia. In addition to the regional airline **Rex**, the **Rex Group** comprises wholly owned subsidiaries **Pel-Air Aviation** (air freight, aeromedical and charter operator) and the two pilot academies **Australian Airline Pilot Academy** in Wagga Wagga and Ballarat.
